SCHWIND AMARIS enthruses refractive surgeons at the ESCRS SCHWIND eye-tech-solutions claims technology leadership

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The world premiere of the new excimer laser generation, SCHWIND AMARIS, at this year's ESCRS (European Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgeons) enthused medical professionals and were a total success for SCHWIND eye-tech-solutions. The large number of visitors at the booth showed extremely strong interest and had the chance to experience the all-rounder's high performance first-hand. The leading technological position of the new excimer laser is primarily based upon the combination of an extremely fast and at the same time precise and safe laser ablation: This is assured first and foremost by a true pulse frequency of 500 Hz, two different energy levels for optimal control of the ablation, as well as the fastest eye tracker on the market which, for the first time, compensates every movement of the eye up to the fifth dimension.

During live surgeries at the Globen Eye Clinic, Stockholm, participants were convinced by the excellent treatment quality and the unequalled safety of the SCHWIND AMARIS. The SCHWIND lunch symposium was also met with great interest, where reference doctors Maria Clara Arbelaez, MD, Oman, Iannis Aslanides, MD, Greece, Carmen Barraquer, MD, Columbia, Francesco Carones, MD, Italy and Tobias Neuhann, MD, Germany, provided a closer look at the SCHWIND AMARIS. More than 300 refractive surgeons were informed of the first study results and the significance of the most important product features from a user point of view. The extent to which SCHWIND's new top-of-the-range model

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convinced the medical specialists at the ESCRS is shown in the first orders. Before the congress was over, ten orders were placed for SCHWIND AMARIS laser systems.

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
